GUIDE FOR EXPORTING YOUR VEHICLE





PREPARE YOUR VEHICLE FOR ITS TRANSPORTATION

- **Remove all personal belongings of the vehicle**
- **Turn off the vehicle alarm or go inoperative**
- **All vehicles must contain a sufficient amount of fuel that is at most $\frac{1}{4}$ of the tank (if this is not the case we will be obliged to charge you for the fuel to be added)**
- **Remove all removable accessories on your vehicle such as fog lights, spoilers.**
- **Make sure that the remaining elements are secure.**
- **If your vehicle is equipped with mirrors "wide angle", fold or disassemble. Fold your antenna or fold it on the roof**
- **Make sure your battery is charged, your tires are properly inflated and your fluid levels are made**
- **Vehicles that lose oil or brake fluid and / or gearbox, must be repaired before boarding.**
- **The seats must remain accessible, and doors should not be locked**

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

- **Original Grey card**
- **Garage purchase invoice that sold you your vehicle, or the seller's certificate of transfer if purchased from a private individual**
- **Certificate of non-pledge**
- **Detailed list of your cargo (if authorized by the company utilized)**
- **Prepare full details of the recipient of your shipment: Name / First Name / Address / Phone / Email**
- **Signed Contract of Carriage (document provided by us)**
- **Conditions of Sale signed (document provided by us)**
- **Certificate of value signed (Document provided by us)**
- **Declaration on honor signed (document provided by us)**
- **Insurance Conditions signed if you have purchased insurance (Document provided by us)**

IMPORTANT

- **We do not transport passengers**
- **We do not do animal transport**
- **We do not take care of wrecks and damaged vehicles**
- **We do not take care of disabled vehicles**
- **Vehicles weighing more than the maximum permissible weight on the registration will be refused**
 - *The costs of parking the vehicle will be charged from the day of delivery on the terminal*
- **The port operator is allowed to weigh all vehicles**
- **Bring your vehicle up two days before the ship closing date which will be given to you**

EGYPT	Banned > 1 year
GABON	Banned > 3 years
EQUATORIAL GUINEA	Banned used vehicules > 12 years and SUV > 15 years
HAITI	Used vehicules banned
IRAK	Banned > 2 years
KUWAIT	Banned > 5 years
LEBANON	Banned > 8 years
LIBERIA	Banned > 10 years
LYBIA	Banned > 5 years
MOROCCO	Banned > 5 years
MADAGASCAR	Interdits > 15 ans
MAURITANIA	Banned > 8 years
PAKISTAN	Banned > 3 years
PARAGUAY	Banned > 10 years
PORT SOUDAN	Used vehicules banned
SENEGAL	Banned > 8 years
SYRIA	Banned
TANZANIA	Banned used vehicules > 8 ans
TUNISIA	Banned except car dealership
URUGUAY	Used vehicules banned
VENEZUELA	Used vehicules banned
YEMEN	Banned > 7 years



KNOWN RESTRICTIONS FOR COMMERCIAL VEHICLES

COUNTRY	RESTRICTIONS
Angola	Banned > 3 years and High Heavy* > 5 years
Saoudia Arabia	Banned > 5 years and Trucks > 10 yars
Democratic Republic of Congo	Banned Big Van > 7 years and High Heavy > 10 years
Ivory coast	Banned > 10 years
Equatorial Guinea	Banned Big Van and High Heavy > 18 yars
Lebanon	Baned > 5 years
Morocco	Banned > 5 yars
Mauritania	Banned > 10 years or 12 years
Senegal	Banned > 10 years
Tanzania	Banned > 8 years
